

# FCCLA Planning Process Worksheet



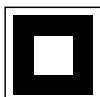
## IDENTIFY CONCERNS

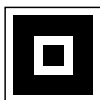

When- This site will be examined by our school's officials and then linked to the Milford Public Schools official site.

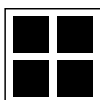
